Lesson Plan: Travel Vocabulary and Grammar

Topic: Travel Vocabulary and Grammar

Level: Intermediate English Students in Vietnam

Objectives

By the end of this lesson, students will be able to:

- **Comprehend** and **utilize** essential travel-related vocabulary in context.
- **Apply** appropriate grammatical structures (future tenses and modal verbs) when discussing travel plans.
- **Develop** listening and reading comprehension skills through travel-themed materials.
- Create a personalized travel itinerary using new vocabulary and grammar structures.
- Engage in reflective practice to self-assess learning progress.

Materials

B. Example Sentences with Notations

1. Using Future Tenses

- Simple Future Tense (will + base verb):
 - I will book a hotel near the beach.
 (Expresses a spontaneous decision or a future action.)
 - 2. They **will visit** the museum tomorrow. (Indicates a planned future activity.)
- Be Going To (am/is/are going to + base verb):

- 3. She **is going to travel** to France next summer. (Shows intention or plan.)
- 4. We are going to explore the city center. (Indicates a future plan based on present evidence.)

Present Continuous for Future Arrangements:

- 5. He **is flying** to Tokyo on Monday. (Refers to a fixed future arrangement.)
- 6. They **are staying** at a hostel during their trip. (Indicates a planned future action with definite time.)

2. Using Modal Verbs

- Can/Could (ability, possibility, permission):
 - 7. You **can take** a taxi from the airport to the hotel. (Expresses possibility or suggestion.)
 - Could we get a city map at the reception? (Polite request or possibility.)
- May/Might (possibility):
 - 9. I **might try** the local cuisine tonight. (Indicates a less certain future action.)
 - She may need a visa to enter the country. (Expresses possibility.)
- Must/Have to (obligation):
 - 11. Travelers **must show** their passports at customs. (Expresses a strong obligation or rule.)
 - 12. We **have to check-in** two hours before departure. (Indicates necessity or requirement.)
- Should/Ought to (advice, recommendation):
 - 13. You **should visit** the ancient temple. (Gives advice or recommendation.)
 - 14. They **ought to book** tickets in advance. (Suggests a recommended action.)
- Will (offers, promises):
 - 15. I **will send** you the itinerary tonight. (Makes a promise.)

16. We **will help** you with your luggage. (Offers assistance.)

3. Combined Vocabulary and Grammar Usage

- We are going to rent a car at the airport.
 (Future plan using "be going to"; vocabulary: "rent," "car," "airport")
- They will explore several tourist attractions during their stay.
 (Simple future tense; vocabulary: "explore," "tourist attractions")
- You must carry your boarding pass at all times.
 (Modal verb expressing obligation; vocabulary: "boarding pass")
- She might miss her flight if she doesn't leave now.
 (Modal verb expressing possibility; vocabulary: "miss," "flight")
- We are hiking in the mountains this weekend.
 (Present continuous for future arrangement; vocabulary: "hiking," "mountains")
- Could you recommend a good restaurant nearby?

 (Modal verb used in a polite request; vocabulary: "recommend," "restaurant")
- I will try the famous local cuisine when I arrive.
 (Simple future tense; vocabulary: "try," "local cuisine")
- They **should check** the weather forecast before the trip. (Modal verb for advice; vocabulary: "check," "weather forecast")

4. Practice Sentences for Students

- Create sentences using the vocabulary words and appropriate grammatical structures:
 - 1. I am going to stay at a guesthouse in Hanoi. (Future plan; vocabulary: "stay," "guesthouse")
 - 2. We **must obtain** a visa before traveling. (Obligation; vocabulary: "obtain," "visa")
 - 3. She **is visiting** the art museum tomorrow afternoon. (Fixed arrangement; vocabulary: "visiting," "art museum")
 - 4. They will exchange currency at the bank. (Future action; vocabulary: "exchange," "currency")
 - 5. You can explore the city on foot. (Possibility/suggestion; vocabulary: "explore," "city")

C. Grammar Notations

Future Tenses:

- Simple Future ("will" + base verb): Used for spontaneous decisions, promises, offers, or predictions without evidence.
- "Be going to" + base verb: Indicates planned actions or predictions based on present evidence.
- Present Continuous for Future: Used for fixed arrangements, usually with a time expression.

Modal Verbs:

- o Can/Could: Express ability, possibility, or permission.
- May/Might: Indicate possibility.
- Must/Have to: Show obligation or necessity.
- Should/Ought to: Provide advice or recommendations.
- o Will: Used for promises, offers, or certain future events.
