

Travel Vocabulary Cheat Sheet

These are simple definitions to help you understand and use travel words!

Transportation Vocabulary

- **Airplane:** A big vehicle that flies in the sky.
 - **Airport:** A place where airplanes take off and land.
 - **Boarding Pass:** A ticket you need to get on an airplane.
 - **Check-In:** When you tell the airport or hotel that you have arrived.
 - **Departure:** When you leave a place.
 - **Arrival:** When you get to a place.
 - **Flight:** A trip on an airplane.
 - **Ticket:** A paper or digital pass you need to travel.
 - **Luggage:** The bags or suitcases you take when traveling.
 - **Taxi:** A car that takes people where they want to go for money.
 - **Train:** A long vehicle that travels on tracks.
 - **Bus:** A large vehicle that many people can ride together.
 - **Car Rental:** A service where you can borrow a car for a short time.

Accommodation Vocabulary

- **Hotel:** A big building where you can pay to stay and sleep.
- **Hostel:** A cheaper place to stay where you might share a room with other people.
- **Reservation:** When you save a place or service in advance.
- **Room Service:** When food or drinks are brought to your room in a hotel.
- **Reception:** The front desk where you talk to hotel staff.
- **Check-Out:** When you leave a hotel and pay your bill.
- **Guesthouse:** A small house where people pay to stay.

- **Bed and Breakfast:** A small place where you pay to stay and get breakfast included.

Activities Vocabulary

- **Sightseeing:** Visiting famous or interesting places.
 - **Tourist Attractions:** Places that many people like to visit.
 - **Guided Tour:** A tour with someone who explains the place to you.
 - **Museum:** A place where you can see old or special things.
 - **Landmark:** A famous or important place.
 - **Itinerary:** A plan for your trip.
 - **Hiking:** Walking in nature for fun.
 - **Shopping:** Buying things from stores.
 - **Photography:** Taking pictures with a camera.

Miscellaneous Vocabulary

- **Passport:** An official book that shows who you are for travel.
- **Visa:** A stamp or paper that lets you enter a country.
- **Customs:** The check at the border where officials look at your bags and papers.
- **Currency Exchange:** Changing your money to another type of money.
- **Map:** A picture of a place that shows streets and locations.
- **Travel Insurance:** A service that helps you if something bad happens during your trip.
- **Backpack:** A bag you carry on your back.
- **Souvenir:** Something you buy to remind you of your trip.
- **Local Cuisine:** Food that is traditional in a place.
